

Jeju, KOREA

Believed to possess four of the world's most beautiful natural wonders according to Michael Bright's **"1001 Natural Wonders to See Before You Die."** In 2007 Jeju's incredible lava tubes and other geological features were also included on UNESCO'S World Natural Heritage List. The sites include Geomunoreum, the Seongsan Ilchulbong, and upper Mt. Halla which takes up about 10% of the area of Jeju. Mt. Hallasan is a unique biosphere with special flora and fauna of both temperate and tropical varieties.



About Venue

Jeju International Convention Center is located in the Jungmun Sightseeing Complex at the south end of Jeju Special Self-governing Province, the best resting place in Korea. It takes about 50 minutes to get there by car from the airport, and it is just adjacent to the seashore southward. Jungmun Sightseeing Complex is the best and largest resort-style sightseeing complex in Korea. It is a perfect for summit meetings and international meetings, offering accommodations, convenient traffic conditions, telecommunications, and security. Leaders of many countries have attended summit meetings at ICC Jeju and regard it as an optimum place for such meetings. ICC Jeju is a clean, pollution-free place. Its average yearly temperature is 14-15°C, and it has an oceanic climate that is warm even in winter. It has distinct four seasons and boasts of beautiful tourist sights.



HOW TO GET TO JEJU ISLAND

Direct international flights arrival at Jeju international Airport(CJU)

Visitors who arrive and depart at the Jeju Airport by direct international flights are eligible for visa waiver. Direct flights to Jeju are as follows :

Regularly Scheduled International Flights

- From Japan ▶▶▶ Tokyo(Narita), Osaka(Kansai), Nagoya
- From China ▶▶▶ Beijing, Changchun, Dalian, Ningbo, Shanghai(Pudong), Shenyang
- From Hong Kong
- From Taiwan ▶▶▶ Taipei

Non-scheduled Flights(including charter flights : availability and flight schedule subject to change)

- From China ▶▶▶ Dalian, Fuzhou, Guangzhou, Hangzhou, Harbin, Macau, Nanning, Qingdao, Wuhan

International flights arrival at Incheon International Airport, gateway to South Korea Regularly Scheduled International Flights

Regularly Scheduled International Flights

- From Malaysia ▶▶▶ Kota Kinabalu, Kuala Lumpur, Penang
- From Thailand ▶▶▶ Bangkok, Chiang Mai, Phuket

Transfer from Incheon International Airport(ICN) to CJU

There are a few flights to Jeju Island with a flight time of approximately one hour.

Take an Airport Limousine bus at the curve side of the arrival terminal to GMP and then fly to Jeju Island.

Your travel itinerary and ticketing should include the GMP ▶▶▶ CJU portion, approximately 1 hour flight.

Transfer from ICN to Gimpo Airport(GMP) to CJU

- Bus schedule ▶▶▶ 05:00 to 21:30 at 5 to 10 min intervals daily
- Bus fare ▶▶▶ 7,000won(about\$6.50) for 30 min ride

Alternatively, board an Airport Railway train from ICN to GMP terminal. Train departs ICN every 30 min.

- Fare ▶▶▶ 10,000won(about \$9) for 30min ride.

Special entry arrangements for Jeju Island

Visa requirements : No need for entry visa to Jeju for passengers arriving at CJU directly from your last international departure point in China, Japan and Taipei.

*This visa is only valid within Jeju Special Self-Governing Province for a stay of up to 30 days. You cannot travel to other territories in Korea.
